Dr. Saravanan Thangamani is a Professor of Microbiology and immunology at Upstate Medical University, Institute for Human Performance. Most recently, he has been in the news for his work in tick and tick-borne diseases surveillance in Upstate New York. His area of special interest is the effect of co-infection on the clinical outcome of Lyme disease and Powassan encephalitis and the impact of ecological changes on geographic expansion of Powassan virus and other tick-borne diseases in Upstate New York.

Dr. Sean Nash is a veterinarian with the Finger Lakes Equine Practice and while he has a special interest in equine ophthalmology, he is developing a particular interest in equine tick-borne illnesses. He will share his understanding of the spread of disease and will offer suggestions for keeping our equines safe from such disease.
